Ebury Community Chest Fund - What is it and how does it work?

he **Community Chest Fund** is part of the Westminster L City Council's Ebury Bridge Social Value programme and is funded by Bouygues UK. The fund focuses on projects that directly benefit residents on and off the estate.

The Community Chest Fund is overseen by the Ebury Bridge Community Partnership Group (CPG). The group wants to fund community projects that benefit a wide age range of Ebury residents, and that can support community cohesion both in the short and long term.

Projects can bid for funding up to £10k that will have local community impact.

If you have an idea for a community project, please see below details on how to apply.

Applications will be considered at each CPG meetings. We advise applicants to send their forms to eburybridge@westminster.gov.uk by the 15 of each month. The CPG meets on the first Tuesday in the month except in August. The Community Chest funding ends in June 2024, therefore the last application deadline will be 15 May 2024.

Construction updates

Phase 1 of the redevelopment of the estate is underway.

Present Work:

Block 7

- Roof is now completed.
- Precast window panels up to L15 (N) L13 (S)
- Façade installation is up to L12.

Block 8

- Concrete for the roof was poured at the end of July.
- Precast window panels up to L12 (N) L8 (S)
- Façade installation is up to L12.

August to September

- Internal fitout ongoing
- Façade installation ongoing including terracotta tiles

Demolition update

Preparation works for the demolition of Phase 2 blocks is continuing throughout the Summer. The following activities will be taking place over the next three months.

August

Scaffold Erection & Enabling Works

- Concrete surfacing will be placed to the East side of Bridge House to act as a foundation for the facing scaffold.
- Scaffold erection will commence to the full perimeter of Bridge House from mid-August and will last for around four weeks.
- The scaffold will be erected by trained professionals who will respect the noise restrictions.
- The team will work between 8am and 4pm, Monday to Friday.

Welfare Installation

- Four welfare cabins will be installed to the North-West corner of Bridge House to the East side of 1 Ebury Bridge Rd.
- These will be quietly and carefully placed into position utilizing a lorry and will be completed over two days.
- These will be the site welfare and they will be occupied by John F Hunt team for the next 6 months.
