### Construction Update

Tith the completion of Phase 1 less than a year away, there's a huge amount of activity on site, see below;

#### Update on the current works

#### **Block 7 & 8**

- Roof steel and Facade Precast panels installation is completed
- Internal fixes are underway, internal walls will be closed-up shortly
- Building Management Unit installation is completed (BMU)

#### **October to December**

- Completion of steel frame and precast facade
- Internal fitout ongoing
- Installation of BMU

#### **January to March**

- Removal of tower cranes and hoists
- Completion of façades and lifts
- Internal fitout ongoing

he following activities will be taking place over the next months. The team will work between 8am and 6pm, Monday to Friday and between 8am and 1pm on Saturday.

#### **Demolition works so far**

- The full perimeter hoarding is complete
- All asbestos has been removed
- Bridge House demolition is complete
- Scaffold to Westbourne House and Rye is installed.

Bridge House: demolition debris has been removed.

Westbourne House: full demolition is ongoing.

Rye House: preparation works, and the soft strip materials are being removed.
