

# Ebury Edge hoarding works

e last notified you about the changes that needed to be applied to hoarding line in Ebury Edge.

The hoarding dividing Phase 1 and Ebury Edge courtyard has been moved by a meter towards the courtyard. This was to host the fire hydrants into Phase 1.

You will notice that a gate is also been installed, this will allow residents to pop by the office or attend housing team surgeries, once the team moves into one of Ebury Edge's units.

We will give you more information on opening times and where to find them once closer to the date.

#### **DONERAILE HOUSE HOARDING WORKS**

Our main contractor, Bouygues UK, will be carrying out upcoming hoarding works near Doneraile House. These will last for approximately three weeks and will start **towards the end of June.**BYUK will display a construction bulletin onsite with all the relevant information and contacts.

- Superstructure is completed
- Façade ongoing with four levels completed
- Internal fit out is ongoing

- Kitchens are being installed on level 2
- Timber floors are being installed on level 2

- Building maintenance units are both installed and are currently being commissioned
