## COVID-19 VACCINE UPDATE

### Vaccines now available for 16 and 17 year olds

COVID-19 vaccines have been extended to anyone aged 16+. If you are 16 or 17 years old, you can now walk in to any of the NHS vaccine clinics in Westminster. The national booking system will be available to book appointments in the coming days.

First and second dose vaccines are available at a number of sites across Westminster. ### Show you've been vaccinated with an NHS pass

We may all be asked to show a COVID Pass to get into some venues or to travel abroad. A NHS COVID Pass shows your coronavirus (COVID-19) vaccination details or test results. Those who are fully vaccinated no longer need to quarantine after travelling to most amber list countries. As of Monday, 16 August, anyone who has been fully vaccinated does not need to self-isolate if a close contact has COVID-19.
