Re: Phase 2 Ground Investigation Works

We wrote to you on 23rd November and 8th December to inform you about the forthcoming Ground Investigation works at Phase 2 of the Ebury Bridge regeneration project. We have now started this work, and the purpose of this letter is to confirm the locations of the drilling and how long we expect each hole to dig.

Most of the works involve digging small trenches or holes for a couple of days at a time, however, two of the holes are much deeper and will take around one week to complete. These two deeper holes also require noisier equipment, but we have requested that our contractors provide noise barriers to reduce the noise as much as possible. We are also working with our contractors to ensure that any fumes from the equipment are diverted away from occupied properties.

Access roads may be blocked for short periods during some of the works, but where this is the case, we will ensure that signs are displayed to advise alternative routes.

At the back of this letter is a map of Phase two which shows the location of each borehole, and how long we expect the digging at each location to take. We also have copies of these available at the office, so please contact the team on the details below if you would like us to go through this with you.

We would like to reassure you that we are doing everything we can to minimise disruption to residents and will only proceed with these works in accordance with the parameters set by the planning authorities.

Due to the nature of the works, they will only take place during normal working hours, 8am – 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am – 1pm Saturday. No works will be carried out on Sunday or during bank and public holidays.

We will continue to update residents about the progress of these works through letters, emails and / or text messages. We will also provide further updates in resident Newsletter which you should receive monthly via post (unless you have opted out).

We apologies for any inconvenience this may cause, and we would like to reiterate that we will minimise disruption where possible.

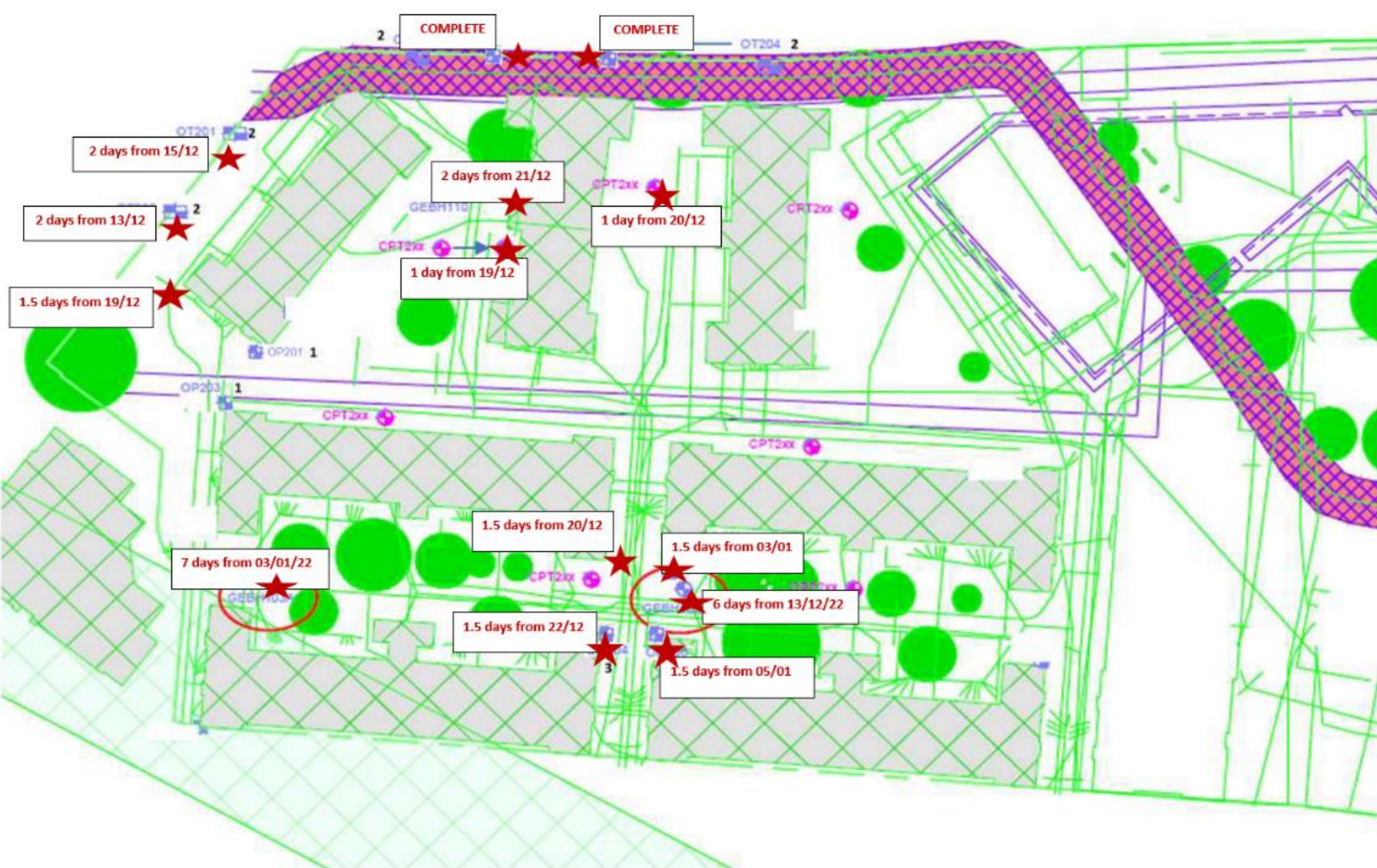
