## **Forthcoming Construction**

We have now reached the stage in the programme where it is time to install the pumps required for the Ground Source Heat Pump- the heating source for the new buildings.

Commencing on the 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2024, the boreholes located in the playground and the service road between the MUGA and Grosvenor Waterside will be fenced off 3-4 times for a duration of 3 hours over the course of the next 2-3 weeks.

The playground will remain open throughout and we don't anticipate these works to cause any disturbance to residents.
